ARTICLE PROCESSING FEE

The first seven (7) accepted articles will enjoy free publication.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

AJRMHS welcomes manuscripts on all aspects of research in basic and clinical medicine and health sciences, especially pertaining to practice and research in developing countries. Submitted articles should not exceed 3,500 words including references.

Title Page: All submissions must include a title page. This should state a running title not exceeding 40 characters and spaces without abbreviations, the names and affiliations of all authors but only, the name, postal address, telephone number and email address of the corresponding author should be indicated. All affiliations should have a lower-case supperscript letter just after the authors name and in front of the appropriate address.

Abstract: Should be structured (Introduction, Methords, Result and Conclusion) and should not exceed 250 words. Include 3 - 5 key words.

Introduction: Give a brief summary of the context, important review of existing literature, rationale, and aim of the study.

Methods: Clearly describe the study design and what measures/procedures were used. Include information on laboratory procedures where appropriate.

Results: State results of the procedures carried out in the research only. Information may be conveyed in text or in figures or tables. All illustrations, figures, and tables should be placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.

Tables should be numbered in Roman numerals (e.g., Table III) and should include a title which makes the meaning clear without referring to the text. Figures/Illustrations should be in finished form suitable for reproduction, as large as or larger than the final size on the page. Photographs should have strong contrast and be trimmed to exclude unnecessary background.

Figures should be planned to fit the proportions of the Journal pages, and details should be easily discriminated at the final size. All illustrations are to be numbered with Arabic numerals as Figures 1, 2, 3 etc. without abbreviation, in the order of their first mention in the text. A short explicit legend must be provided for each figure.

Discussion: Include an explanation of what the results imply and discuss their significance and relationship to those of others.

Conclusion: Here, state the significance of the major findings of the study.

Conflict of Interest: All authors must declare any potential conflicts of interest.

Acknowledgements: Acknowledge any support received towards the research work.

Funding: Where supported by a grant, the source must be indicated.

Ethical approval: Approval of relevant Ethics or Institutional Review Board should be specified, if applicable.

References: Referencing should be in Vancouver style. In the body of the manuscript, references should be listed numerically in superscript after punctuation. A list of references should be provided at the end of the document in numerical order, according to the sequence in which they are cited in the text.

- Text Font & Style: (the entire manuscript)

 Text Font Style: Times New Romans
- Text Font Size: 11 and single-spaced.

 All pages of the manuscript should be numbered consecutively at the bottom right corner.

SUBMISSION: All manuscripts should be submitted in 2 seperate Microsoft word files as follows:

- 1. Non-blinded article file: This should contain the full contents of the article, inclusive of names and affiliations at which the study was done or acknowledgements.
- 2. Blinded Article file: The main text of the article, beginning from Abstract till References (including tables/figures) should be in this file. It must not contain any mention of the authors' names or initials or the institution at which the study was done, or acknowledgements. Page headers/running titles can include the title. Manuscripts not in compliance with the Journal's blinding policy will be returned to the corresponding author. Do not zip the files.
